SUBJECT: Approve the Policy/Finance Committee recommendation for Board consideration

with regard to proposed Blue Sky Program proposals and authorize the APCO to

execute related documents.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the Policy/Finance Committee recommendation for funding as presented in Attachment 1 in the amount of \$250,000 for AB 2766 proposals and \$329,999.74 for AB 923 proposals.

ALTERNATIVE:

Approve alternative funding levels than those recommended by the Policy/Finance Committee.

BACKGROUND:

The District's Blue Sky Grant is composed of \$4 Motor Vehicle Registration Fees (AB 2766) and \$2 Motor Vehicle Registration Fee (AB 923). The AB 2766 portion provides incentive and grant funds for air quality projects designed to reduce motor vehicle (mobile source) air pollution. The California Air Resources Board (ARB) issues guidelines providing criteria for AB 2766 funded projects. Projects have been reviewed by the District staff to weigh eligibility, viability, local health impact, district goals, emissions reduced, and cost-effectiveness criteria. The Committee then reviews the projects and makes a recommendation for approval to the Board of Directors.

The AB 923 portion may be used for limited project types which include school bus replacements and retrofits according to the Lower Emission School Bus Program Guidelines.

The District initiated fiscal year 2019/2020 Blue Sky Grant Request for Proposal (RFP) on August 12, 2019, and closed the RFP on October 14, 2019. The RFP was noticed in the Appeal Democrat newspaper, mailed to all local jurisdictions plus any interested parties, and posted on the FRAQMD's website at http://www.fraqmd.org. The District staff also held a public workshop on September 17, 2019, on the Blue Sky Grant.

The AB 2766 proposals were reviewed by the District to determine eligibility then score based on the factors listed in section V. Evaluation Criteria of the Request for Proposals. The District reviewed the AB 923 projects to determine eligibility.

The Policy/Finance Committee reviewed the proposals and the District staff recommendations at a public meeting on November 4, 2019. The Policy/Finance Committee unanimously approved the funding levels in Attachment 1.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The District has approximately \$250,000 available for the AB 2766 portion and \$350,000 available for the AB 923 portion.

DISCUSSIONS:

The FY 2019/2020 Blue Sky Grant proposals received seven proposals for the AB 2766 funding requesting a total of \$280,899.40. All of the proposals were found to be eligible by District staff and have been recommended for funding by the Policy/Finance Committee. The total requested from all projects exceeded the available funding by \$30,899.40. The Committee recommended funding two proposals at 70% of the requested amount.

The District received three proposals requesting \$434,999.74 for AB 923 funding. The three proposals would each replace one existing diesel-fueled school buses with a new diesel-fueled school bus. The Policy/Finance Committee recommended funding two bus replacement projects with the available funding and referring the remaining proposal to the AB 617 Community Air Protection Funds Program. This would leave a balance of \$20,000.26 in the AB 923 program funding that would be made available to projects in the following Blue Sky Program Solicitation.
