General Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for funding, projects must meet criteria described in the 2017 Carl Moyer Program Guidelines, the FARMER Program Guidelines, and all current Carl Moyer Program Advisories. These criteria include but are not limited to the following:

- Emission reductions obtained must not be required by any federal, state or local regulation, memorandum of agreement/understanding with a regulatory agency, settlement agreement, mitigation requirement, or other legal mandate.
- Projects must meet a cost-effectiveness established by the District and calculated in accordance with the cost-effectiveness methodology in the 2018 FARMER Guidelines.
- No emission reductions generated shall be used as marketable emission reduction credits, or to offset any emission reduction obligation of any person or entity.
- No project funded shall be used for credit under any federal or state emission averaging banking and trading program.
- Funded projects must have at least 75 percent of their total activity for the project life in California.
- Emission reduction technologies must be certified/verified by the ARB for sale in California and must comply with durability and warranty requirements.
- The owner and equipment must be in compliance with federal, state, and local regulations.

Off Road Vehicle Eligibility Criteria

- The existing vehicle can be an ATV, UTV, or a tractor less than 25 horsepower.
- The existing vehicle must be used in agricultural operations.
- The new UTV must emit zero tailpipe emissions from its onboard source of power (such as all electric or hydrogen fuel cell vehicles) and may not be modified to allow propulsion by any other means.
- The new UTV must have a towing capacity of 500 pounds or greater and a total vehicle weight of 700 pounds or greater.
