Applications will be accepted from **January 12, 2026, to March 16, 2026 at 5:00 pm**. Please note that applications received less than 10 business days prior to the deadline may not be reviewed for completeness before the deadline. Interested applicants are encouraged to submit applications early to have the greatest opportunity to be reviewed and have time to correct any errors or omissions. Please note that additional information may be requested from the applicant in order to process this application.

General Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for funding, projects must meet the criteria described in the 2024 Carl Moyer Program Guidelines and all current Carl Moyer Program Advisories. These criteria include but are not limited to the following:

- Emission reductions obtained through Carl Moyer Program projects must not be required by any federal, state or local regulation, memorandum of agreement/understanding with a regulatory agency, settlement agreement, mitigation requirement, or other legal mandate.
- Projects must meet a cost-effectiveness established by the District and calculated in accordance with the cost-effectiveness methodology in the 2024 Guidelines. All state funds plus any other funds under a district's budget authority or fiduciary control contributed toward a project must be included in the cost-effectiveness calculation.
- No emission reductions generated by the Carl Moyer Program shall be used as marketable emission reduction credits, or to offset any emission reduction obligation of any person or entity.
- No project funded by the Carl Moyer Program shall be used for credit under any federal or state emission averaging banking and trading program.
- Funded projects must have at least 75 percent of their total activity for the project life in California.
- Emission reduction technologies must be certified/verified by the ARB and must comply with durability and warranty requirements. For the purposes of the Carl Moyer Program, a technology granted a conditional certification/verification by ARB is considered certified/verified.
- **Only one application per person/farming operation/business entity will be accepted per year.**

Off Road Equipment Eligibility Criteria

- If actual engine hp cannot be determined, hp can be estimated by the following:
$$\text{Engine hp} = \text{Power Take Off} \times 120 \text{ percent}$$
- New engine must be within 135 percent of the horsepower of the existing engine. However, if there is no equivalent equipment within original horsepower range or the higher horsepower

equipment would result in equal or lower annual emissions, the air district may approve a greater than 135 percent increase in horsepower.

- The owner and equipment must be in compliance with federal, state, and local regulations. Use the tables below to determine if existing equipment is eligible for funding.
- For fleets subject to the Off-Road Regulation, applicants must submit DOORS ID, EIN, and results of fleet calculator.

APPLICATION PACKAGE CHECKLIST

The following items are required to be submitted to apply to the Carl Moyer Program:

- Completed and signed Application.
- Evidence that the property on the application is covered by liability insurance.
- Photograph of hour meter showing current reading.
- Documentation supporting annual usage for the previous 24 months
 - This may include copies of repair work orders for the equipment that provide a date and hour meter reading, maintenance records with receipts attached that are specific to the equipment and performed at intervals based on usage, employee timesheets specific to the equipment, or usage records with operational time for equipment.
- Proof existing equipment ownership, submit copies of either:
 - Bill of sale for existing equipment from dealership or authorized seller. Private party bill of sale not acceptable documentation unless notarized.
 - Or one of the following items that covers at least the previous 24 months:
 - Tax depreciate logs listing the equipment
 - Property tax records listing the equipment
 - Insurance records listing the equipment
 - Bank appraisal for the equipment
 - Service records from a third party that identify the equipment
 - Maintenance records for the equipment with receipts
 - General ledgers
- Documentation to show equipment was operational the previous 12 months, submit copies of one of the following:
 - Revenue and usage records with operational, standby, and down hours for equipment.
 - Routine inspections which document the operating condition of the existing equipment (OSHA or workplace required).
 - Employee time sheets link to equipment usage.
 - Preventative maintenance records tied to usage hours for specific equipment with receipts.
 - Repair work orders specific to equipment.
- ARB certification (executive order) for new equipment engine from dealership you will be purchasing the equipment.
- New equipment itemized price quote and spec sheet from dealership you will be purchasing the new equipment.
- Warranty documentation for new equipment from dealership you will be purchasing the new equipment.
- For non-agricultural off-road equipment, submit DOORS certification showing compliance.
