If so, we encourage you to apply for the Air Quality Specialist I position with the Feather River Air Quality Management District.

THE POSITION:

The Air Quality Specialist I is the entry-level class in the Air Quality Specialist class series. Initially under close supervision, incumbents with an educational background and/or practical experience learn technical air quality control principles and practices and related inspection techniques. As knowledge and experience are gained, the work becomes broader in scope; assignments are more varied and are performed under supervision that is more general. This class is alternatively staffed with Air Quality Specialist II and an incumbent may advance to the higher-level after gaining the knowledge, skill, and experience that meet the qualifications for and demonstrate the ability to perform the work of the higher-level class.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

Education:

Equivalent to graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with major coursework in engineering, biology, chemistry, environmental science, physical sciences, or a field related to the work. Additional experience as defined below may be substituted for the required education on a year-for-year basis.

Experience:

Air Quality Specialist I: No experience is required. An internship or related paraprofessional experience is desirable.

License:

- Must possess and maintain a valid California class C driver's license and meet automobile insurability requirements of the District as a condition of continued employment.
- Must obtain within six months of appointment and maintain a California Visible Emissions Evaluation Certificate.
