SUBJECT: Authorize a Budget Amendment of \$1,310.00 for FY25/26 the Streamline and DocAccess Website Services for compliance with new ADA regulation.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the requested budget amendment.

ALTERNATIVE:

Do not approve the requested budget amendment and provide direction to staff.

BACKGROUND:

Due to the new ADA regulation that requires state and local government websites and mobile apps to comply with WCAG 2.1 Level AA standards by April 2026 or April 2027, depending on their size. This final rule, issued by the Department of Justice, mandates accessibility for all digital content and services provided by these public entities. Key requirements include making content compatible with assistive technologies, ensuring keyboard navigation, providing captions for videos, and ensuring text can be resized. the District will need to have an accessible compliant website by April 24, 2026.

The District's website is managed by Streamline. Streamline has been working with DocAccess to come up with a service that is affordable and can provide the District with the capability to update and maintain the FRAQMD website to ensure that it is ADA compliant. The District can contract with DocAccess through Streamline at a monthly rate of \$200 and the District will be able to keep the website ADA compliant as per the new regulation. This will reduce the risk of a lawsuit under the Americans with Disabilities Act or various state laws, including the Unruh Civil Rights Act in California.

FISCAL IMPACT:
